- NIH Director Dr. Francis Collins, along with directors of other institutes <u>testified</u> before the Senate L-HHS subcommittee on NIH's FY17 budget request.
- An NIH-funded study <u>found</u> that children with Cushing syndrome may be at a higher risk for suicide.

- Another <u>study</u> found that a single screening question about drinking frequency in the past year could help doctors identify adolescents at risk for alcohol problems.

- An aid for those suffering from post-traumatic stress is service dogs. Given that they are not considered standard of
 care, <u>One Mind</u> supports efforts being undertaken by American Humane Association (AHA) to do the research
 necessary to make service dogs an accepted standard of care.
- One Mind has also teamed up with the Department of Defense to explore long-term effects of blast injuries. The
 Institute also recently completed its 'Concussions' campaign to support hospital follow-up visits for patients involved
 in brain research studies.
- <u>IMHRO</u> has joined forces with <u>PatientsLikeMe</u> to better understand issues faced by patients with post-traumatic stress and traumatic brain injury.
